The story of this wine. The Pearl—this wine’s namesake—is a very rare and precious object, uniquely created by nature. They can be hard to find but worth the search. Our White Wine, La Perle, shares many of the qualities of these valuable orbs. Inspired by the rare and valuable whites of the Rhône region, this limited production blend strives for the complexity and beauty that our carefully chosen vineyard blocks bring forth.

Winemaker Tasting Notes. “This inaugural white Rhône blend opens with a rich and aromatic perfume of pear, meyer lemon, buttered apple, honeysuckle, and hazelnut oil. It is rich and full-bodied on the palate, featuring honeyed citrus, pear, and floral elements, while retaining a lively acidity from the Roussanne. This wine is showing beautifully right away, but these blends can age very nicely for many years.” - Chris Peterson, Winemaker
