The Story of This Wine. The pearl—this wine’s namesake—is a very rare and precious object, uniquely created by nature. They can be hard to find but worth the search. Our white wine, La Perle, shares many of the qualities of these valuable orbs. Inspired by the rare and valuable whites of the Rhône region, this limited production blend strives for the complexity and beauty that our carefully chosen vineyard blocks bring forth.

Winemaker’s Tasting Notes. “This wine starts with an exotic nose of white peach, Asian pear, tangerine, tropical flowers, honeysuckle, lychee, and vanilla oil. The palate shows great richness and purity of flavors: stone fruits, pear, salted honeydew melon, beeswax, orange water, white tea, and toasted almonds. This wine has really jumped out of the gates to please, but these blends can age for a decade more of enjoyment. Drink now-2035+.” - Chris Peterson, Winemaker
