**The Story of This Wine.** Dry rosé wine is perfect for inspiring creativity and joy, so we named it after the French word for “muse”. This limited release is made from traditional Provençal varietals, and features delicious red fruit and floral notes, in a salmon pink robe. It’s a perfect wine for a summer day, or night, or whenever your spirits could use a lift.

**Winemaker’s Tasting Notes.** “Summertime aromas of wild strawberry, raspberry sorbet, pomegranate seeds, citrus peel, seashell, and hints of dried thyme. The palate is electric with vine-ripened strawberry, raspberry hard candy, watermelon rind, tangerine pith, and savory herbs. This is a rosé that will drink well this summer as always, yet it has the concentration and acidity to last in the cellar for a few years as well.” - Chris Peterson, Winemaker

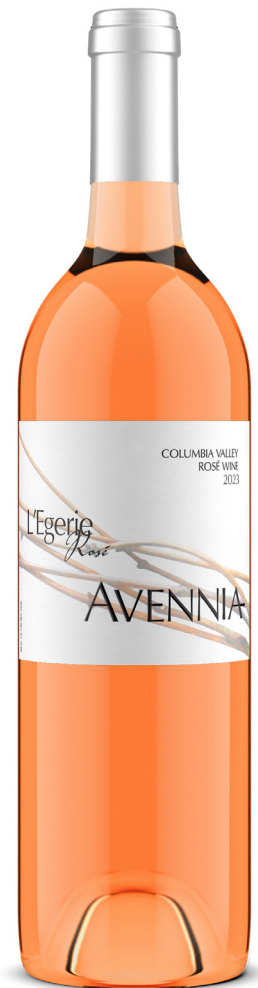
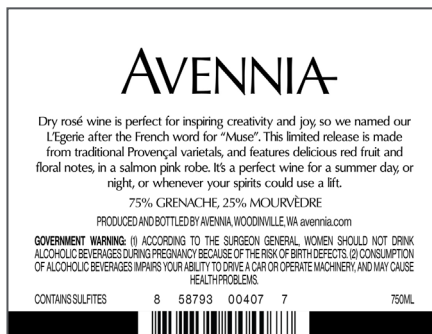
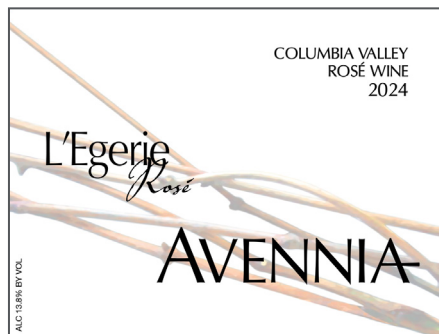
